LOCATION

Auctions are typically conducted online via the HiBid auctions platform. Sellers can watch and listen in to the selling process live online via HiBid as the bidders make their bids. Every online auction advertised on the Manshed Auctions Australia website links to the relevant online auction site at HiBid.

On-site auctions are also our speciality and can be organised by arrangement.

SELLER'S FEE

A seller's commission (i.e., consignment fee) will be charged for every item sold by Manshed Auctions Australia, whether under the hammer or by negotiation after the auction. The standard seller's commission is 13.75% (inclusive of GST on the commission), but where the seller requests that Manshed Auctions Australia collect the item for consignment, the seller's commission is a minimum 16.5% (inclusive of GST). If the collection requires extra time, effort or cost on the part of Manshed Auctions Australia, the seller's commission may be higher as negotiated with the seller. In every instance the seller's commission will be clearly disclosed on your consignment contract.



PAYMENTS

Sellers typically receive the proceeds of the sale of their items within 14 days following the auction. This is subject to the timely payment from the purchasers within the stipulated time frame. Should any delays occur beyond our standard time frame, we will notify you and the reason for any delay. Manshed Auctions Australia will not make payment for and is not liable to make payment for any items sold through us until we receive the full cleared funds from the purchaser
