



BIDDING AND BUYING AT MANSHED AUCTIONS AUSTRALIA

Buyers should refer to the full **Auction Terms & Conditions** and familiarise themselves with the auction conditions and fees before registering and bidding.

Key Information for Buyers:

- All intending bidders must register before bidding
- The easiest way to register to bid is online through HiBid at hibid.com
- Caveat Emptor (buyer beware) applies to each and every lot
- While a packing and freight service is provided on most items, please check with us before bidding on large or fragile items to ascertain that your item can be posted or freighted and what the associated costs might be
- All successful bidders must pay a buyer's premium on top of the final hammer price
- For railway and collectables auctions, the standard buyer's premium is 20% plus GST
- For motorcycle and motorcycle parts auctions, the standard buyer's premium is 15% plus GST
- The minimum buyer's premium for any bidder is \$5.50 (inclusive of GST on the premium)
- Floor bidders are usually required to make immediate payment for their items



- Invoices will be issued within 24 hours after the closure of the auction to all successful bidders who have at that time not yet paid for their items in full
- Bidders who receive an invoice must pay for their items within 24 hours after the issuing of the invoice (unless otherwise indicated in writing by Manshed Auctions Australia)
- EFTPOS and credit card facilities (Mastercard & Visa) are available to pay for your items live and over the phone; merchant fees apply on credit card transactions
- Successful bidders must make arrangements to collect their items within one month of the day of the auction otherwise the right of ownership over those items will pass immediately to Manshed Auctions Australia
- Items must be paid for in full before a postage or freight quote can be provided
- Items posted or freighted are not specifically covered by insurance in transit unless you advise us in writing to arrange that your items are to be insured by the freight company or Australia Post to a specific monetary value
- Manshed Auctions Australia takes no responsibility for lost or damaged items posted or freighted whatsoever
